How long will it last? Owl Encounter - 11:00 – 1:00pm  
Hawk Walk – 11:00 – 1:00pm  
Falconry Morning – 10:30 - 1:00pm  
Photography Mornings - 11:00 – 1:00pm  
Hunting Day – 10:30 – 3:30 (with lunch!)

Please arrive promptly for the start of your experience.

You are more than welcome as part of your experience (at no extra cost) to stay and enjoy the afternoon displays at 1:30 and at 3PM (during the centres open season).

## Checklist

### 1) Weather

The experiences are weather dependant to ensure the safety of the birds, so its always best to check before you set off! If it's too windy or rainy, we will rearrange your experience for another date.

### 2) Clothing

Warm shoes and a coat are a must, just in case! The hawk walk and falconry mornings take a walk through the woods, so flip flops are a no

### 3) Bring a Camera – this is particularly helpful on the photography morning.

You're more than welcome to take photographs; the birds don't even mind the flash!

### 4) Voucher Expiry

Please note, that the vouchers do expire, the date of expiry will be written on the voucher. Please check our website for available dates, to make sure you don't miss out.

### 5) Spectators – Not available on Hunting Days

Spectators are more than welcome to come along and take photos of you with the birds. To spectate, the cost is £15, and again, you're more than welcome to stay for the two flying displays during the centres open season. Spectators will not be allowed to handle birds during the experience.
